Annual Governance Statement for the Governing Body of Sheering Primary School September 2022

In accordance with the Government's requirement for all governing bodies, the 3 core strategic functions of the Sheering Primary School Governing Body are:

- 1. Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction.
- 2. Holding the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils.
- 3. Overseeing the financial performance of the school and ensuring it's available funds are used effectively.

Governance arrangements	The Governing Body of Sheering Primary School has seen a number of changes leading up to the 2021/22 year with some long serving governors coming to the end of their term. The board is supported by new parent governors that have joined the committee as their children took up new places in the school as well as new Governors joining from a community orientated perspective. The Governing Body is supported by a professional clerk.		
	The Full Governing Body meets once each term and twice in the autumn term. A Resources committee further considers school spending and income, the school buildings and grounds and in particular health and safety. We also have committees that meet if required to consider pupil discipline and urgent staffing matters such as appointing a new head teacher should that be necessary.		
Attendance record of governors	Governors have good attendance at meetings and we have never cancelled a meeting because it was not "quorate" (the number of governors needed to ensure that legal decisions can be made).

school premises both inside and out.

The last two years have been a difficult time for schools as they have had to work around and manage Covid restrictions. Sheering school has consistently provided on site schooling through this period in particular supporting the children of key workers who were unable to keep children at home during 'lockdown'.

Governors have also been challenged during this period as on-site visits and meetings were highly restricted and thereby normal levels of engagement between governors and teachers were difficult to maintain albeit online meetings and committees have been possible. Going forward we are looking forward to a return to on-site Full Governor Board meetings alongside 'virtual' Resources meetings. We have made the decision not to have a Personal and Curriculum committee instead including these topics into the Full Governors Board meeting.

The Resources committee ensures that school budgets are used effectively and continually assess health and safety criteria to ensure that the school is a safe and rewarding environment for children. The Governors also consider how the additional Sports Premium and Covid and other special funding has been allocated through the year.

Future plans for the Governors

During the 2022/23 school year Governors will be focused on supporting the teaching structure, and will carry on ensuring that continuous improvements are being made at the school in the form of improvements to academic results as well as further enhancements to the school physical environment.
