This term seems to have gone really quickly with all the celebrations, hard work and events since the new year. On Thursday, Rev'd Sophie reminded the children of the Easter story and the reason why we have been thinking about Forgiveness as our Christian value this half term. It was good to see how much the children had remembered. The children were also very good at making links with their learning when we learnt about the Muslim festival of Eid at the beginning of the week; they made comparisons between some of the celebrations and important events in both religions.

#### **Parent Questionnaire Analysis**

Thank you to those of you who returned your questionnaire. The answers have helped the governors and the school to review and evaluate the things that we are doing well and what needs developing. There was a range of both positive and negative responses; many of you thanked the school for the support and opportunities that your children are receiving while others had concerns about behaviour, after school clubs and sports day. From the 29 responses; 93% of you say that your child enjoys coming to school (7% neither agreed or disagreed) and the same amount said that the school was welcoming and there were opportunities to get involved. 82% think that the teaching is good with 18% neither disagreeing or agreeing. 82% also thought that the school keeps the children safe (14% neither agreed or disagreed and 4% disagreed). Only 35% of you thought that the school deals effectively with unacceptable behaviour (35% neither agreed or disagreed and 30% disagreed).

In response to the comments about behaviour, as a school we recognise how challenging behaviour has become and we have made positive changes to our behaviour policy (September 2024) which have been effective in dealing with low level or disruptive behaviour in class. We have also had a significant reduction to fixed-term exclusions for very challenging behaviour. We invested in My Happy Mind to help support the children with their emotions and we always try to support parents in setting good habits in the use of mobile phones and the internet, bedtimes and diet so that these things are not impacting on behaviour in school. Behaviour is an area which the governors will continue to monitor and as a school we will continue with our consistent approach in making sure that learning is not disrupted by anyone.
