Dear Parents,

At Sheering school this week, we introduced a new tool, Zones of Regulation which is helping us to manage our thoughts, feelings and actions, making sure that we are ready for our learning. This was introduced to us by one of our parents who sees it being used effectively in many other schools. Since the children have returned after the two lockdowns, we have noticed how anxious, angry or unsettled some of our children are and Zones of Regulation will help the children to recognise their emotions and feelings (happy, fidgety, angry, frustrated, nervous etc) and use the tool kit independently to bring themselves back to the green zone. I have attached the PowerPoint I used with the children and staff, as you could employ some of the strategies to support your children at home.

Coronavirus Restrictions Update

You may have heard of the lifting of further coronavirus restrictions which will come into effect from May 17th. For Sheering School this will mean that we can now begin to plan school trips and the Year 5/6 residential trip.
