This year we are raising money to buy a Clevertouch screen for Quickbury class, outside seating for the playground area and a willow garden for the back field. I would like to thank Sharon Northrop, Debbie Monk, Vera Muldoon, Dot Taylor and Leigh Dennison for being the driving force behind the PTFA and for the impact that their time and energy has had on enhancing learning at our school.
