

Sheering CE Primary School

Sport Premium 2014-2015

Context

All schools have received a grant from the government to improve physical education (PE) and sport over three academic years. To date Sheering has received a total of £8,450.

Overview of use and impact of funding

At Sheering school, the funding has been used to raise standards for all children in physical education and to increase pupil's participation in competitive school sport.

This includes:

- Level two membership of the Harlow School Sport Partnership.
- CPD training for the PE subject leader allowing her to develop her role.
- Employment of specialist sports coaches for games- Hendon Hawks.
- Employment of a play leader to raise the level of participation in active games during lunch time.
- Attending sports festivals run by HSSP, including funding for releasing teachers and transport.
- Purchasing additional PE resources (equipment)
- Developing the playground area of the school- the playground is now safe and fit for purpose for playtimes, PE lessons and sports clubs. The playground has been resurfaced, new fencing has been installed and the school council have been involved in designing the new markings which will be added to the playground during the autumn term 2014.
- Establishing a weekly after school netball club for years 3-6.
- Working closely with the link teacher from Leventhorpe School to develop games curriculum and teacher's subject knowledge.

We plan to now further develop provision in PE by offering a wider variety of after school sports clubs. Furthermore, through the employment of specialist coaches to work alongside our teachers we will ensure that high quality PE lessons are being delivered. We aim to participate in inter school sports competitions and have registered for inter-school sports fixtures with Leventhorpe as well as HSSP.

Summary

The spending of this funding will continue to be monitored, evaluated and reviewed by the governing body to ensure that it is being used effectively to improve the quality and breath of PE and sport which delivered and available to the children at Sheering school enabling them to develop and maintain healthy lifestyles.
